- Check the straps are secured appropriately prior to driving: Use correct lifting techniques - Secure with wire to prevent from fall through windy conditions once placed on the ground.

Service Portable Toilets**Toilets onsite:**

Portable toilets should be located in a secure place with safe access.

They should be:

Placed on stable, flat ground to ensure effective operation and stability
accessible by a clear path suitable for all weather conditions positioned in a well-lit area at all times serviced regularly to keep them clean.

Make sure that the toilets are secured by use still pick and wire to prevent from moving or falling.

Make sure the doors of the toilets are well closed.

Users to use toilet paper provided on site to prevent blockage when pumping out.

Pump out Portable:

- Use correct lifting techniques
- Be aware of your surroundings
- Follow client site rules, and induction if required
- Liaise with client regarding pets
- Check there is nobody in the toilet
- Operator has vaccinations
- Check visually that there is no contamination in the toilet, other than wastewater
- Wear PPE (gloves)

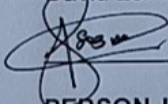

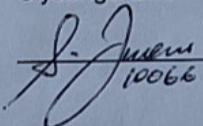

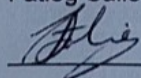
