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Storage / Removal of materials, Waste & By-Product:

- Drums will be supplied and placed in the yard area for general litter and will be cleaned before the drum overflows.
- Any plant that is to be serviced will be done so on a drip tray/canvas etc. All

materials that are used or replaced, will be removed from site by the technician and disposed of at the workshop facility.

- If there is a requirement for grease and oil remnants to be collected, a separate bucket type container will be supplied. The materials will be disposed of in a responsible manner, through our workshop facility.

Description (How the activity will be carried out)

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| (1) All employees will be inducted, and records will be kept, in the proper disposal of all waste. |
| (2) A litter clean-up will be held once a week to prevent prolonged litter being evident on the site. |
| (3) Domestic Waste will be managed from the main camp area |
| (4) The disposal of the waste will be done regularly with the on-site LDV to a refuse disposal site. |
| (5) Hazardous material – Large quantities of hazardous waste will be disposed of at an approved landfill site and the necessary SDC's will be obtained. |
| (6) Used oil and grease will be removed from site to a suitable facility. |
| (7) Used oil, lubricants and cleaning materials from the maintenance of plant will be removed in holding drums and disposed of through our workshop facility. |
| (8) All bins on site will be scavenger proof, weatherproof and tip proof. |
| (9) Burning or burial of any waste will be prohibited. |
| (10) At the landfill site waste will be sorted and place in different skips for recycling purposes. |
| (11) Building rubble will be disposed of at a site which manufacture recycled gravels and necessary SDC's will be placed on file, if they are issued. (Gordon's Bay landfill site does not issue certificates for dumping) |
