NOTIFICATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORIZATION FOR: THE PROPOSED REPAIR AND UPGRADE OF THE EXISTING DEGRADED STORMWATER INFRASTRUCTURE ALONG MAIN ROAD ("MR") 269 AT KM 4.95 AND KM 5.67 AND ALONG DIVISIONAL ROAD ("DR") 1257 AT KM 1.47, HEMEL & AARDE VALLEY, BETWEEN SANDBAAI AND CALEDON.

This Environmental Authorisation authorises:

The **Department of Transport and Public Works** applied to repair and upgrade two existing highly degraded storm water infrastructures (Culverts) at Km 4.95 and Km 5.67 along Main road 269, Hemel & Aarde Valley, and one storm water infrastructure (Culvert) at Km 1.47, along Division Road 1257, also known as the Tesselaardal Road. GNEC was appointed as Independent Environmental Consultants to carry out the required EIA Process for the proposed repairs and upgrades.

This letter serves to inform you that the Department of Environmental Affairs Mr D'mitri Matthews has granted Environmental Authorization for the above mentioned project on the 04th of August 2016.

The reasons for authorization are summarized in the Environmental Authorization herewith attached.

Appeals:

Should you as an Interested and Affected Party (I&AP) not agree with the Department of Environmental Affairs Authorization herewith attached, and would like to lodge an appeal.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of Government Notice No. R993, which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. An appellant must submit an appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant.
