In accordance with Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014 (as amended) we hereby notify you of the decision to **grant Environmental Authorisation (EA). The application may undertake the listed activities specified in Section B in the attached EA in respect of the preferred alternative. The decision has been issued on 29 August 2024** by the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning (DEA&DP) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act 107 of 1998, as amended).
