In accordance with Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014 (as amended) we hereby notify you of the **adoption of the final MMP in terms of NEMA** as issued by the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning (DEA&DP) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act 107 of 1998) on the 11th June 2024. The applicant may undertake the maintenance activities associated with the maintenance and management of stormwater structures and infrastructure, specified in Section C of the attached adoption document.
